

## INSTRUCTIONS TO PERSONNEL

# When there is concern about a student's well-being

There may be a need to guide a student to Student Health Services if

- the studies do not progress
- there are repeated absences
- the student has returned to studies after a long sick leave
- the student has experienced grief; the loss of a loved one, divorce, illness etc.
- the student is worried about his/her coping or health
- there is concern about the student's well-being

In an emergency, always call emergency telephone number 112.

### SORA legislation (Unsuitability to study legislation)

Remember that it is the duty of the personnel to intervene in a situation where there is a suspicion that the student is under the influence of drugs when carrying out practical assignments or practical training belonging to studies, or there is a suspicion that the student has drug addiction.

Drug testing applies to all students. SORA fields (fields of unsuitability to study) differ as regards disciplinary sanctions aimed at students. These sanctions regarding the studies are defined more in detail. The public health nurse will make a referral to drug test only based on a written request submitted by the educational institution.
